Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$20,707,996. which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the school district, or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.” (Majority vote required).*If article S-3 for the collective bargaining agreement passes, this article will be reduced by \$61,206.
