

We dedicate our 2005 Town Report to Cathal "Chuck" O'Ceallaigh - in appreciation of his many years of volunteer service.

Chuck came to Barrington in 1992, when looking to settle with his family in the country. He immediately thrust himself into the community by volunteering on the Advisory Budget Committee. In September of 1994, he was asked to fill an unexpired Selectmen's term. He went on to become one of Barrington's longest serving Board members.

In addition to being a Selectman, Chuck was the Board's liaison to the Planning Board, serving during some of their most challenging and active years. Despite a busy schedule Chuck also volunteered at recycling, taught computer classes for the Library and Recreation Department and steered the newly organized Economic Development Committee. His background in computer technology has proven invaluable to the Town and School District.

Balancing out his political side was Chuck's coaching career for one of our soccer teams. His quest to support the children of Barrington led to his participation in fund raising efforts to construct a soccer field behind the elementary school and in acting as chaperon for the school district's ski program. A graduate of the Kennedy School at Harvard University and UNH, Chuck holds a Masters Degree in Political Economics. He has worked tirelessly in applying these principles through every aspect of his community service. Often referring to himself as, "a democrat with a small 'd'", Chuck always put the needs of the Town before his own. A sterling example of volunteerism is what Chuck brought to this Town. We are honored by his devotion and commitment and wish him luck as he moves on to pursue other endeavors, namely as a ski instructor at Loon Mountain! Town Elections are always held on the 2nd Tuesday in March.

Tax Bills are mailed out in June and December.

Tax Abatement Form is due by March 1st.

Tax Credit or Exemption Form is due by April 15th.
(Includes Veteran's Tax Credit, Elderly, Disabled
and Solar Exemptions.)

Tax Deferral Form for Elderly and Disabled is due March 1st.

Current Use Application Form is due by April 15th.

Report of Wood or Timber Cut is due by May 15th.

Dogs must be licensed no later than April 30th.
