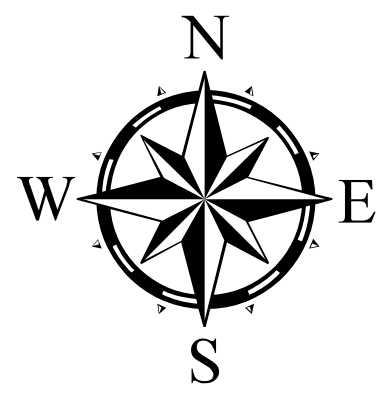
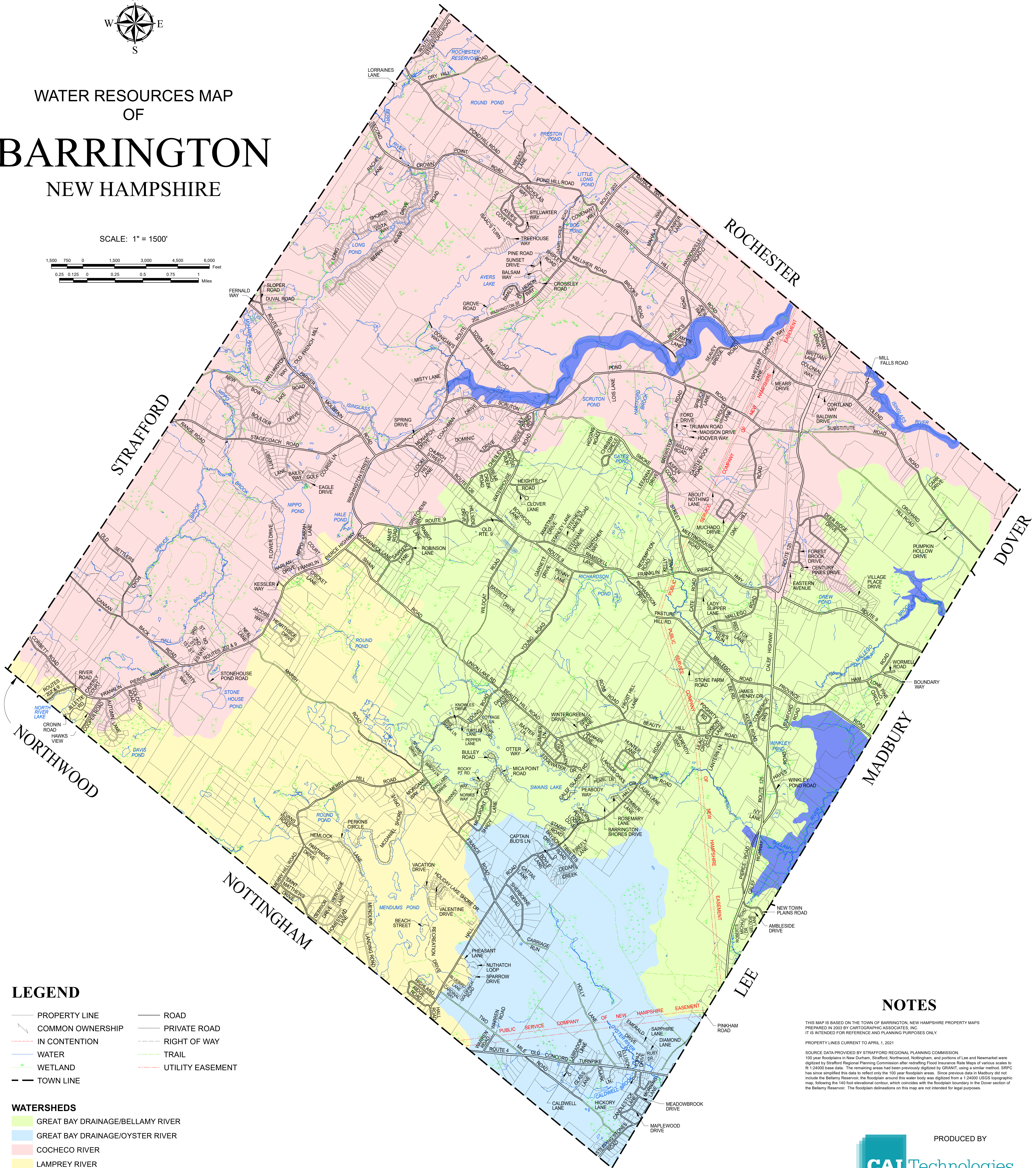
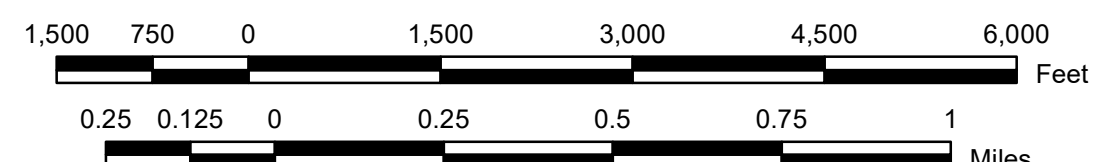




# WATER RESOURCES MAP OF BARRINGTON NEW HAMPSHIRE

100-year floodplains in New Durham, Strafford, Northwood, Nottingham, and portions of Lee and Newmarket were digitized by Strafford Regional Planning Commission after redrafting Flood Insurance Rate Maps of various scales to fit 1:24,000 base data. The remaining areas had been previously digitized by GRANIT, using a similar method. SRPC has since simplified this data to reflect only the 100-year floodplain areas. Since previous data in Madbury did not include the Bellamy Reservoir, the floodplain around this water body was digitized from a 1:24,000 USGS topographic map, following the 140-foot elevational contour, which coincides with the floodplain boundary in the Dover section of the Bellamy Reservoir. The floodplain delineations on this map are not intended for legal purposes.
