

The Barrington Trails Committee meeting was conducted via Zoom due to lack of availability of meeting space.

Meeting was called to order at 6:35pm.

Minutes of 8/24/21 were accepted as amended.

Old Business:

There were 7 people on the 9/11 walk led by Jack on Brasen Hill Farm. The trail was not completely dry. A water snake was seen. Blazing was done on Jeb's Jaunt. Anne will lead the 10/9 October fall foliage weekend walkabout on Calef West.

On Goodwill, the Beaver dam trail needs blazing. The timber harvesting has been stopped due to wetness. It will resume in the winter. A space for a small 4 car parking lot has been cleared. There is a locked gate on the Ross Rd access.

SELT's Land Manager T. Parker Schuerman has applied for a permit to put a sign on the Ann Tibbetts Schulz easement costing \$75. The town will ask that this cost be waived.

New Business:

Work sessions will be set up for Marika's Ledge trail. We still haven't heard from the Great Bay Rotary Club. A session was set up for Friday 10/1. Charlie will be out of town between 10/7 and 10/14. Work sessions will be needed on the Barrington Trail between Brewster Road and Scruton Pond Rd.

Industrial Arts class will make signs for Brasen Hill. We still need to hear where Theo wants the trail to go from the parking lot. John will contact him.

We still have no meeting place. We may have to change the day of our meeting. Connor is looking into availability of ECLC.

Our November 13 Weekend Walkabout will be during deer season. TBD

We will plan to walk the trail from Emerald Acres MHP that connects to Tibbetts Road.

Charlie has the contact list for the MHP and will solicit volunteers. We discussed the hazard tree problem they are having which is being handled by the Town Lands Committee.

John reported there are only a few trails booklets left. Calef has them.
