Old Business:

Updates: PDF's have been sent out for the Goodwill parking area and are due 6/14/19.
Calef East Trails are now all blazed. Charlie and Anne completed blazing and raking the Big Rock Loop.
May 11 Weekend Walkabout on the Winnie the Pooh trail went well led by Jennie. The June 8 Weekend
Walkabout will be on Calef East. Charlie will lead.

RFP's are out for a forester to provide services on town owned lands and are due 5/23/19.
The Blue Trail on KOTR needs to be blazed with blue paint. A small kiosk needs to be added.
Calef Preserve bog bridge, tree removal and beaver dam trail work session was discussed and
subsequently scheduled for 5/16/19.

New Business:

There is a problem with mud trucks going on the power lines, through the Oyster River, leaving Pierce
Rd to enter SATWASR and trying to pull down gates. Getting a trail cam was discussed and will be
brought up at the Conservation Commission meeting.

Calef East needs a work session to relocate part of the Marsh Trail.

Theo Wiegand owner of Brasen Hill Farm will be contacted to walk out with members of the Trails
Committee to sort out the trails on Brasen Hill. John and Charlie have ideas for possible trails to the
tailings and to SATWASR.

8/10/19 Anne will lead a walk on the Barrington Trail starting at the ball field.

The wet crossings on the Village Place Trail and the Hemlock Trail need a bridge and a bog bridge.
We need a work session on the Barrington Trail (north end) for pruning and removal of trees from the
trail.

The wet part of the Pond Trail needs rerouting on Newhall.
