Updates:

Proposed change to the Trail Trekker list: the Barrington Trail will be divided in three parts: Barrington Trail North, Barrington Trail Middle, and Barrington Trail South. Betsy will be asked to add these to the map.

Jack discussed the plans for "The Bear" events. Paint Night with Lauren on 10/3. There will be an evening book group discussion on 10/10. The Barrington Trails Committee hike 10/21 will include discussion of survival skills, how not to get lost, etc.. There will be a Barrington Hiking Bear Raffle at the end of the hike. We will continue collecting cans for buckthorn to discourage new growth on Calef East and other locations.
