  - There is requirement for a hydrologic study

## Long Shore Land Owners Association (LSLOA)

- Melissa and Patrick Lessard have provided a list of Town owned lots w/ lot specific notes.
- The list includes abutters and/or potential parties that may be interested in the lots if made available.
- Note: If the lot is a pre-existing conforming lot then a house can be built, but the septic system setback requirements may be prohibitive.
- A condition of sale of these lots should include that these lots cannot be divided.
- There are potential funds from Fish and Game to build a boat launch.
- What rules regulate sale or lot line adjustment for Town owned properties?
  - O Does the property need to go out for bid?
  - Are there specific rules regarding abutters?
- The committee has decided to set up a date/time for a field visit to investigate some of these properties along with Melissa and Patrick Lessard.

## Tamposi Land

- UNH Thompson School has expressed interest in allowing students to conduct a Forestry Management Plan. A professional Forester will need to sign off on the plan.
- Anne Melville reported that John Wallace and Charlie Moreno discussed a management plan for the rabbitat, as well as the rest of the property.
  - Possible NRCS funding. Land and Forest Management requirements come with this funding.
- Approximate cost range is \$5k \$10k
- If Town pays for plan the money will need to be budgeted soon.
- One thought is to publish a Request for Proposal (RFP)
