

Primary purpose of the meeting: Kick off Meeting for the update to the Barrington Master Plan Housing Chapter.


- 1. Introduction of Staff and Housing Steering Committee.
 - Vanessa Price, Towner Planner, introduced the steering committee members, Joyce Cappiello, John Driscoll, Tracy Hardekopf, Bob Caverly, Gilbert Smith; Town code enforcement deputy, Jayme Jameson; and Strafford Regional Planning Commission (SRPC) Senior Regional Planner, Lisa Murphy.
 - Vanessa passed out the current 2016 chapter of the Master Plan Housing Chapter.
 - Vanessa turned over the presentation to Lisa with SRPC to present the overview of the Master Plan, what the goals are for the project and timeframes for meeting milestones.
- 2. Discussion by SRPC for the Overview of the project and timeframe for completing milestones. (Refer to PowerPoint presentation attached.)
 - Lisa discussed the purpose of a Master plan and the need for it to be updated every 5- 10 years.
 - The Barrington Planning Board, at the October 25, 2022, met for a work session discussion with regards to the Housing Opportunity Planning (HOP) Grant Program. HOP grants will be administered by Plan NH under contract with NH Housing. The Town has obtained the grant opportunity for the Needs Analysis and Planning for the Housing Master Plan Chapter.


- The execution of the grant award started on January 25, 2023, and will continue to the expiration of July 31, 2024.
- The committee members had a brief discussion on how there will be changes from 2016 until now.
- Lisa discussed that data collected from a community survey, and public forum and community outreach will give the data to see what the housing trends in Barrington are.
- Discussion that there are factors that result in the growth of a community.
 - i. Co-Vid
 - ii. Climate change
 - iii. Affordability.
 - iv. Younger families move into the area because of the recreation programming.
- 3. Discussion on community survey. (Working draft copy attached to these meeting minutes.)
 - Lisa presented to the steering committee the drafted survey questions for the housing chapter. Questions reviewed would be Town of Barrington Specific.
 - Discussion to have identifier questions,
 - Reviewed Housing Key questions, questions 1 15.
 - Will continue at the next meeting questions on the survey relating to demographics and deeper dive into housing.
 - Lisa also asked the steering committee to think if there were different questions that can be discussed at the next meeting.
