ORDINANCE NO. 87-3
CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate the consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages.

Section 2. Motor Vehicles: No person shall consume or possess in an open can, bottle or other container any alcoholic liquor or beverage as defined by Chapter 175 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, while upon or in a motor vehicle upon any way, as defined by Chapter 259:125 (I), (II), of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, or any public sidewalk, municipal parking lot or municipal property within the limits of the Town of Barrington.

Section 3. Public Areas: No person shall consume or possess in an open can, bottle or other container any alcoholic liquor or beverage as defined by Chapter 175 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, while upon any school property, public areas, parking lots open to the public or within any municipal building without written consent of the official who has authority and control over said property, within the limits of the Town of Barrington.

Section 4. Penalty: The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall not exceed \$500 for each offense.*

Section 5. Separability: If any section of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, the remaining sections not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Takes Effect: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
