

Barrington, NH Recreation Commission Minutes June 18, 2020

Call To Order: Doug Langdon called the meeting to order at 10:45

Jessie began by informing the commission on the construction proposal document that Careno has provided

Steve expressed to Jessie that Careno should give the department and commission more turnaround time for the signing of documents going forward

Doug believed the signing authority for the Recreation Director was set in the past at \$10,000

Doug also voiced his concern of signing this proposal without allowing time for the select board to review the documents

Jessie stated the Recreation Commission was placed on the agenda for the July 27th select board meeting to update the town on this proposal

Doug stated he would feel more comfortable if upon the signing of the document, a disclaimer would be included which would state this signature of the recreation director would not be final until the select board is able to review the document during the July 27th select board meeting

Jessie will reach out to Ben Careno and propose this caveat to her signature

Doug motioned to allow Jessie to sign the proposal with the disclaimer that it will be fully approved by the select board during the July 27th select board meeting Steve seconded, vote unanimous

Select Board Meeting:

Jessie informed the Recreation Commission they are on the agenda for the July 13th select board meeting, where the select board will be providing proposed changes or revisions to the MOU. The recreation commission stated this was not the intent of their June 9th meeting. During the June 9th meeting, the MOU was referenced by Doug when discussing a work session between the Recreation Commission and Select Board. However, there was no discussion or intent by the commission to seek proposed revisions of the MOU.

Jessie will reach out to Dale, who will clarify to Town Administrator McIver there was no intent to seek revisions of the MOU at any point. The commission plans on attending the July 27th select board meeting to discuss the status of the addition/fire separation and seek approval for Careno's construction proposal.

Doug Langdon motioned to adjourn at 11:05, Steve Graves seconded, vote unanimous.
