YOUTH SKI & SNOWBOARD PROGRAM AT GUNSTOCK MOUNTAIN RESORT
AGES 6 – 19 (Grades 1-12) and ALL ABILITIES

PROGRAM: The Barrington Recreation Department is excited to offer another year of the Youth Ski & Snowboard Program at Gunstock Mountain in Gilford, NH. This program is geared towards the ski and snowboard skill development of youth, and depends on parent participation and volunteering. This is a four week program for residents of all abilities.

The parent/guardian will provide constant adult supervision during their time at the mountain. The Barrington Recreation Department will be facilitating the program, but will not be chaperoning or providing supervision at any time. This is a parent/guardian driven program. There will be no transportation provided by the Barrington Recreation Department. Parent/guardian must transport themselves & their child(ren) to the mountain.

PLEASE NOTE: Parent Volunteers, Barrington Recreation Department Coordinators, & Gunstock employees may speak to your child if conduct warrants. Discipline can be up to, but not limited to, exclusion from program.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: The deadline to register for this program is Thursday, November 8, 2018. Payment must be made in full at the time of registration. Gunstock's Online Registration opens on Monday, October 1, 2018.

DATES OF PROGRAM: The program will be held on Sundays for four (4) weeks, January 6, January 13, January 27 and February 3.

GROUP SIZE: We must have at least twenty (20) participants registered by this date to be able to offer this program. Maximum group size is 50 participants.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS: It is **expected** that parents volunteer for one of the positions below. In order for Gunstock to offer this program, Barrington Recreation Department must provide a number of volunteers every Sunday. Upon registration, please indicate which Parent Volunteer position you will be signing up for. This program **cannot** operate without parent volunteers.

First Aid Volunteer: The First Aid Volunteer will be responsible for meeting any participants (adult or youth) at First Aid if a major injury occurs. Their responsibility is to help return equipment if necessary, grab ski bags from lodges, and other small tasks that might have to be done at this time. It is **NOT** the First Aid Volunteers responsibility to assess injuries or provide first aid. It is **imperative** to have a cell phone on you at all times. Please check in every Sunday with the First Aid office to introduce yourself and give them your cell phone number.

Lesson Chaperones: Gunstock requires the Recreation Department to provide parent Lesson Chaperones to ski/ride with each lesson group. The size of the group will determine how many chaperones are needed per group. The responsibilities of the Parent Chaperone are to provide the Gunstock Ski/Ride Instructor with behavior management support and group management. Parents will be chaperoning the lessons. These lessons are **NOT** meant for parents, they are designed for under 18 years of age. If you are signing up to be a lesson chaperone, please only volunteer to chaperone a skill level that you are comfortable skiing/riding with. Lesson Chaperones should arrive at the lesson area at 10:45. Please find the instructor of your group and aid him/her in gathering youth participants.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Thursday, November 8, 2018. Gunstock's Online Registration opens on Monday, October 1, 2018. We must have at least twenty (20) participants registered by Thursday, November 8 to be able to offer this program. Maximum group size is 50 participants.

The cost and structure of the program has changed for both adults and youth, please read this packet completely.

COST OF OUTREACH PROGRAM FOR YOUTH PARTICIPANTS

Youth Participants: This year youth participants will be issued a student program pass which is good for the season. Since our group lessons will be on Sundays, you will need to purchase the Student Winter Prime Season Pass. This pass must be attached to their jacket or snow pants each week. If your child loses or forgets their pass, they will need to purchase a \$10 replacement in order to participate. No exceptions! These passes are non-transferable and no one should ever use the pass other than the person it is purchased for. *Note: If youth participant is enrolled in the Outreach program, he/she does not need a Flex Pass.*

Cost for Youth Participants:

Youth Ski Lift & Lesson (4 wks): \$249*

Youth Snowboard Lift & Lesson (4 wks): \$249*

*Rental gear is complementary for students on scheduled Outreach lesson days

COST OF PROGRAM FOR ADULT PARTICIPANT & IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBERS

Available to any outreach participant's family is a \$29 Flex Pass. The Flex Pass holder can purchase regular priced Primetime or Night lift tickets for half price, any day of the week! Just bring the Flex Pass to the ticket counter for a half price Primetime or Night lift ticket! Each person will need their own Flex Pass as these are non-transferable and are only valid for the person listed on the pass. *Note: If youth participant is enrolled in the Outreach program, he/she does not need a Flex Pass.*

Cost for Adults & Immediate Family Members:

Flex Pass: \$29 (one time cost paid at time of online registration)

Flex Pass tickets are available for half the price of the regular daily price tickets.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE OUTREACH & THE FLEX PASS PROGRAMS

You will be signing up and paying for your child(ren) online through the Gunstock website at www.gunstock.com. Registration opens on Monday, October 1, 2018. Please use the Outreach Online Registration Instructions to guide you through the registration process. Registration deadline is Thursday, November 8, 2018.

- Sign & Return the registration packet that are enclosed to the Rec. Office by November 8th.

ITEMS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION DEADLINE (Thursday, November 8th)

- 1. Register online & Payment in Full** - participants will not be considered registered until payment is received in full.
- 2. Registration Packet (Pages 5-9 in this packet)** –the registration packet must be filled out completely for each participant and returned to the Recreation Office for your child(ren) to be considered registered, regardless if payment online has been made.
 - a. Cover Sheet**
 - b. Barrington Recreation Department Registration Form** – regardless if participants already have a yearly registration form on file, a new form must be filled out completely & signed by a parent/guardian.
 - c. Parent Volunteer Sign-Up**
 - d. Gunstock Outreach Participant Release of Liability** - must be filled out completely & signed by a parent/guardian. Student waivers will be completed online. We only need a waiver completed for flex pass participants/volunteers/chaperones.
 - e. Gunstock Rental Waiver & Agreement- *if renting only.*** Must be filled out completely & signed by a parent/guardian.
- 3. Email Address** - Our program relies primarily on email for coordinating and communicating with parents and students. Please be sure to include all email addresses that you wish our program to utilize when communicating program updates and cancellation information, if needed, during the day and evenings.

LESSON INFORMATION

GUNSTOCK LESSON INFORMATION: The Gunstock Ski and Snowboard Program requires youth participants to attend lessons. Lessons are for youth only. Parents/Guardians are not offered lessons through this program.

Please note: The hour allotted for lesson time will include lift lines, riding the lift, organizing the group, and the instructor's lessons. This will allow for one or two runs on the slopes. The instructor will have another lesson directly after your group's lesson and will make a judgment call on whether there will be enough time for one more run before getting back to the lesson area for his next group.

***Important Note:** There are **NO** lessons offered to Parents'/Guardians'.

PARENT CHAPERONES DURING LESSONS: Gunstock requires the Recreation Department to provide Parent Chaperones to ski/ride with the lesson group. The responsibilities of the Parent Chaperone are to provide the Gunstock Ski/Ride Instructor with behavior management support and group management. Please keep in mind that this is a parent/guardian volunteer driven program and this program will not be able to operate without your support.

Please note: Parents/guardians may chaperone lessons in groups other than their children's, if desired.

YOUR DAY AT GUNSTOCK

ITINERARY: The ski/ride day schedule is as follows:

8:30-10:00a.m.: Families arrive at Gunstock, gear up, & pick up lift tickets (if necessary) from the ticket office.

8:30-11:45a.m.: Enjoy skiing with your family.

11:45-11:50a.m.: Parents, chaperones, and child(ren) arrive to lesson.** Please arrive at 11:45 to give yourself plenty of time to find your lesson group! There will be **many** other participants, chaperones, and instructors in the same area – it will be busy!

12:00-1:00p.m.: Child(ren) attend lesson. Chaperones aid instructors. Non-chaperone parents can choose to ski behind lesson or ski on their own for an hour. Please see the above note under Gunstock Lesson Information for an important note.

1:00 p.m.-closing time: Enjoy skiing with your family!

RELEASE OF LIABILITY PLEASE READ CAREFULLY***

WARNING: All forms of skiing, snowboarding, recreational activities and the use of aerial and surface lifts are hazardous. Falls and injuries are a common occurrence. Recreational users of the ski area must use deliberate and conscious control and proper equipment, both on the ground and in the air, in relation to ever changing variables and dangers. Safety is directly affected by personal judgment in the severe elements of mountain forest terrain. Ski and/or ride within one's own ability. Be alert to continually changing weather, visibility and surface conditions and other inherent risks including but not limited to: existing and changing surface or sub-surface snow and ice conditions, dirt, grass, bare spots, forest growth, trees, rocks, stumps, and other natural objects and collisions with or falls resulting from such natural objects, lift towers and components thereof, lights, signs, posts, fences, mazes or enclosures, hydrants, water or air pipes (all the foregoing whether above or below the snow surface), snowmaking and snow grooming equipment, marked or lighted trail maintenance vehicles and snowmobiles, other man-made structures or objects and their components, and collisions with or falls resulting from such man-made objects; variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or as a result of slope design; snowmaking or snow grooming operations, including but not limited to ski jumps, roads and catwalks or other man-made or natural terrain modifications and features including Freestyle Terrain; the presence of and collisions with other skiers and riders and the failure of others to ski and ride safely, in control or within their own ability.

I, the undersigned, hereby express my desire and approval for myself or my child's participation in the Learning Center Program. I acknowledge that such participation will include, without limitation, participation in various types of snow-sports instruction and activities and the use of Gunstock equipment, as well as the slopes, trails, Freestyle Terrain and related facilities, including ski lifts. I further acknowledge that participation in the program is voluntary and entirely at my risk and/or that of my child. I understand that recreational and other activities involve inherent and other risks of **INJURY** and **DEATH**. I agree that having a resort employee present does not lessen the amount or severity of the risks or hazards of these activities. I assume all risk of personal injury or loss of property as defined in **RSA 225A:24** (Responsibility of Skiers and Passengers).

I acknowledge that my child's involvement may include skiing, snowboarding, the use of Freestyle Terrain, lifts and participation in other recreational activities, and that these activities are **HAZARDOUS** and I or my children have made a voluntary choice to participate in these activities despite the risks.

I hereby promise not to bring a claim against or sue, and AGREE TO RELEASE Gunstock Area, Gunstock Area Commission, the County of Belknap, their shops, employees, owners, affiliates, agents, landowners, officers, directors, and their successors in interest, any equipment manufacturers and distributors, (collectively "Releases"), **from all liability for injury, death, property loss and/ or damage that results from participation in recreational activities, that is in any way related to participation in the Learning Ctr. Program, the use of the equipment, or is related to any other activity at Gunstock including all liability that results from the NEGLIGENCE OF Releases, or any other person or cause.**

I further agree to **DEFEND, INDEMNIFY** and **HOLD HARMLESS** Releases for any loss or damage arising from claims or lawsuits related in any way to myself or my child's participation in the program, use of the equipment, or any other activities on Releases' premises. I understand that permission to use Releases premises, and myself or my child's involvement in this program is being given in exchange for the execution of this Release of Liability.

I authorize Releases to administer first aid as they deem necessary. I authorize transportation to a medical facility, at my expense, if deemed necessary by Releases. Further, in the case of serious illness or injury, if I cannot be reached, I give permission for treatment, including medical and/or surgical care necessary for the well-being of myself or my child, at my expense. I agree that upon transporting my child, to any medical facility, clinic or hospital, that the responsibility of the Releases shall be totally fulfilled and the Releases shall have no further responsibility. I understand that Releases will, to the best of their ability, attempt to notify me as soon as possible in the event of an emergency. I hereby grant exclusive permission to Releases and their respective agents, clients and assign to use myself or my child's name and image(s) for the purpose of publicity, public relations, editorial, or other advertising purposes without restriction as to frequency or duration. I acknowledge that this agreement is governed by the applicable laws of the State of New Hampshire. I further agree that any action involving parties or issues relating to or arising out of this agreement must be instituted and prosecuted in the state or Federal courts of New Hampshire. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect. I HAVE CAREFULLY READ, UNDERSTAND, AND VOLUNTARILY AGREE TO THIS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN MYSELF AND THE RELEASEES THAT LIMITS MY, OR MY CHILD'S LEGAL RIGHTS AND I SIGN IT OF MY OWN FREE WILL.

I acknowledge and agree that I have read the foregoing release and that by signing this release I agree to be bound by its terms. ___ **Type I Skiers: CAUTIOUS** skiing at lower visual indicator settings, prefer slow to moderate speeds, prefer gentle to moderate terrain, receive lower than average visual indicator settings. This may increase the risk of inadvertent binding release in order to increase the likelihood of release in a fall. Type I settings apply to entry-level skiers uncertain of their classification.

___ **Type II Skiers: MODERATE** skiing at average visual indicator settings, prefer a variety speeds. Prefer varied terrain. Type 2 skiers are skiers who do not meet all the descriptions of Type I or Type 3 skier types.

___ **Type III Skiers: AGGRESSIVE** skiing at higher visual indicator settings, prefer fast speeds. Prefer steep terrain. Receive higher than average visual indicator settings. This may reduce the likelihood of release in a fall in order to decrease the risk of inadvertent binding release.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL & LIABILITY RELEASE AGREEMENT: I agree on behalf of myself or on behalf of the minor user I am representing to accept for use **AS IS** all equipment to be provided during the multi-week program, and I agree to accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in the user's possession. I will be responsible for the replacement at full value of any equipment provided under this form, but not returned to the shop. I agree all rental equipment will be returned by the agreed date. I acknowledge that Gunstock will set the visual indicator settings on mine or the minor's skis in accordance to the manufacturer's specifications and the height, weight, shoe size, age, skier type, experience, head size and other information requested, I have provided on this form. **I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety.** In downhill skiing or ski boarding, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding and Telemark skiing (collectively RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS), the binding systems will not ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation. I understand that the sport of skiing, snowboarding and other RECREATIONAL SNOWSPORTS involve inherent and other risks of **INJURY** and **DEATH**. **I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death** that may result from skiing/snowboarding use, participation in this multi-week program, or which relate in any way to the use of the equipment to be issued to the user. I understand that a helmet designed for RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS use will help reduce the risk of some types of injuries to the user at slower speeds. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn. **I AGREE TO RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Gunstock ski/snowboard shop, its owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the manufacturers and distributors of the equipment and their successors in interest (collectively PROVIDERS) from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment users participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding, participation in this multi-week program, or is in any way related to the use of the equipment, including all liability that results from the NEGLIGENCE OF PROVIDERS, or any other person or cause.** I further agree to defend and indemnify PROVIDERS for any loss or damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death, and property loss and damage related in any way to the use of the equipment or participation in this multi-week program. This agreement is governed by the applicable law of this state or province. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

Welcome to Outreach

Gunstock's Outreach Program offers affordable access to winter sports for youth, ages 6 to 19 as of 12/31/2018. This 4-week educational program offers participants four days of lessons, rentals, and skiing or snowboarding. In addition, students choose either a midweek or prime season pass which they may use all winter, depending on the weekday of their program.

To enroll in Outreach, parents and guardians purchase the pass for their child(ren) online, plus select the discipline – ski or snowboard – for their lesson and/or rental. Our improved e-store simplifies family account management and enrollment for new and returning Outreach participants. Families returning from last season can use the information from their RFID card (season pass) to find their existing record in our new system, and everyone else will need to create new account profiles.

In general, we recommend you follow these steps to register to use our updated e-store to manage your family accounts and to enroll your child(ren) into the Outreach Program.

1. Go to <https://estore.gunstock.com> from a web enabled computer or mobile device.
2. Register to create or locate the customer profile for the parent or legal guardian who will enroll the program participant(s). This person must be 18 years or older.
 - a. Pro Tip: Enter the WTP or GSM/GSW number printed on your personalized RFID card, if you have one, to locate your existing customer profile.
3. Create or locate the customer profile for each program participant to associate them to your customer profile.
 - a. Pro Tip: Enter the WTP or GSM/GSW number printed on their personalized RFID card, if they have one, to locate their existing customer profile.
4. Select the desired Outreach Pass, Lesson and Rental for each student participant and designate them as the 'party member' for each product.
 - a. Please note that these will all have a default online price of \$999.
 - b. Products can only be assigned to participants aged 6 to 19 as of 12/31/2018.
5. Enter the Outreach Code provided by your program coordinator. The \$999 default online price will change to the actual program price at this point. Lesson and rental products will become \$0 as these are included on scheduled program days.

6. Complete the digital waiver for each program participant. This must be done by the parent or guardian for anyone age 6 to 17. Adult program participants, age 18 or 19, will be sent a separate email so they can sign their own waiver as they are considered to be legal adults.
7. Provide your credit card or debit card payment to complete the purchase. Confirmation and adult waiver emails will be sent at this point.
8. Follow-up with your coordinator to formalize your lesson and rental registration.
 - a. You will need to determine the participant ability level for lessons.
 - b. You will need to complete registration paperwork for rentals.
9. Start to ski or snowboard when Gunstock opens in early December, if you want, even before the Outreach Program begins. Just remember your program lessons and rentals are only for scheduled program days.
 - a. If the program participant has a personalized RFID card, they can go straight to the lift if their electronic waiver is complete.
 - b. Otherwise, visit the Welcome Center to pick up the participant's personalized RFID card and/or to sign any unsigned waivers and have a pass photo taken.
