**PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR THE DISABLED
RSA 72:37-b**

To qualify for this exemption the applicant must have been a resident of New Hampshire for at least the last five (5) years and a resident of Barrington on the previous April 1st. The applicant must also provide a letter from Social Security stating that they are disabled and receiving benefits under Title II or Title XVI of the Federal Social Security Act.

The property for which the exemption is claimed must be the applicant's principal place of abode and owned by either the applicant or the applicant's spouse. If the property is owned by the spouse, they must have been married to the applicant for at least the past 5 years.

If the property is held in a life estate or trust, applicant must provide a copy of the trust instrument and complete form PA-33.

INCOME LIMITATIONS

**Single: \$30,000
Married: \$50,000**

Examples of income are: pension employment, interest from savings or other interest-accruing accounts, dividends from stocks, bonds, securities, money markets or certificates, annuities and rental income

ASSET LIMITATIONS

Total Asset Limit: \$75,000

All property (except the property for which the exemption is claimed), is an asset whether located in New Hampshire OR out of state.

Some examples of assets are: savings / checking accounts, mutual funds, money markets, stocks, bonds, annuities, term life insurance policies, (current value of each), IRAs and other retirement accounts, vehicles, boats, trailers, campers, RV's, tractors, heavy equipment, household goods and personal items such as jewelry, antiques, coins, furs, etc. Anything that could be turned into cash is considered an asset.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

1. Documentation that proves you have been a resident of New Hampshire for at least the last five (5) years.
2. Documentation proving that you were a resident of Barrington as of the previous April 1st.
3. W-2 forms, Interest and Dividend forms, Tax Returns, etc. Any and all claims you make as to your income and asset status must be supported with documentation.
4. A letter from the Social Security office stating your disabled status and that you are receiving benefits under Title II or Title XVI of the Federal Social Security Act.

IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR THIS EXEMPTION, A RESIDENT MUST BE ELIGIBLE AND RECEIVING BENEFITS UNDER TITLE II OR TITLE XVI OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT FOR BENEFITS TO THE DISABLED.
