Emergency Order #12 Pursuant to Executive Order 2020-04

Temporary modification of public access to meetings under RSA 91-A

Pursuant to Section 18 of Executive Order 2020-04 it is hereby ordered, effective immediately, that:

- Pursuant to Executive Order 2020-04, paragraph 8 provides: "State and local government bodies are
 permitted and encouraged to utilize the emergency meeting provisions of RSA 91-A to conduct meetings
 through electronic means while preserving, to the extent feasible, the public's right to notice of such
 meetings and ability to observe and listen contemporaneously."
- Pursuant to Emergency Order #2 issued pursuant to Executive Order 2020-04, gatherings of fifty people or more are prohibited.
- 3. To implement these orders and recommendations, the requirement in RSA 91-A:2, III(b), that a quorum of a public body be physically present unless immediate action is imperative, is waived for the duration of the State of Emergency declared in Executive Order 2020-04.
- 4. To further implement these orders and recommendations, the requirement in RSA 91-A:2, III(e), that each part of a meeting of a public body be audible or otherwise discernible to the public "at the location specified in the meeting notice as the location of the meeting," is waived for the duration of the State of Emergency declared in Executive Order 2020-04 so long as the public body:
 - a) Provides public access to the meeting by telephone, with additional access possibilities by video or other electronic means;
 - b) Provides public notice of the necessary information for accessing the meeting;
 - Provides a mechanism for the public to alert the public body during the meeting if there are problems with access; and
 - Adjourns the meeting if the public is unable to access the meeting.
