 - b. Reverse Involuntary Lot Merger Map 206, Lot 15 Vote
 - i. State statute continues to require municipalities to authorize the reversal of involuntary lot mergers at the property owner's request.

 - iii. Staff and Town counsel have reviewed the request and confirmed that the lots were involuntarily merged.
 - iv. The Select Board is asked to consider authorizing the reversal of the involuntary lot merger on Map 206, Lot 15.
 - c. 2020 Preliminary Assessment Ratio Discussion
 - i. The Town's Assessor has completed the preliminary ratio of assessed values.
 - ii. See attached, Preliminary Ratio Report 2020 Barrington
 - iii. Once the State finalizes the 2020 Equalized Ratio, the Board may need to consider commissioning a statistical update for 2021. This would be similar in timeline and scope to the 2017 statistical update. Sale values continue to rise, and it is important to keep the assessed values in line with the market value. If Barrington's Equalized Ratio exceeds 10% (+/-), an update would be required. The cost for a statistical update in 2021 would be approximately \$18,000 in addition to our annual assessing services.



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- iv. The Board will discuss this topic further once the equalized ratio is finalized.
- d. Intersection Sidewalk and Safety Project Support Letter Vote
 - i. The Select Board was asked to send a letter of support for consideration by NHDOT regarding sidewalk safety enhancements at the intersection of Route 9 and Route 125. It is believed that these improvements will support the development of the Town Center, which the Town has been working to develop for over 10 years. There have been a number of residential developments approved and proposed that will contribute to the necessary foot traffic and density that supports commercial/retail development. The Barrington Middle School is located within the area proposed for sidewalks. The sidewalks play a critical role in Barrington's safe development of this area. In addition, a granite-curbed sidewalk has already been installed on Community Way off Route 9 as part of a subdivision to support the development of the Town Center. The proposed project would connect to the existing sidewalk.
 - ii. The Select Board is asked to consider authorizing a letter of support for this project.
