



## BARRINGTON, NH NON-PUBLIC SELECT BOARD MINUTES

Monday, October 18, 2021

The Select Board meeting for Monday, October 18, 2021 began at 6:30pm. The meeting was held at the Early Childhood Learning Center (ECLC), 77 Ramsdell Lane, and was also accessible by remote participation via a Microsoft Teams Meeting. In attendance were Chairperson Knapp, Vice-Chair Saccoccia, Selectperson Ayer, Selectperson Mannschreck, Town Administrator (TA) MacIver, and Municipal Office Administrator (MOA) Caudle.

### **NON-PUBLIC SESSION**

**10:20pm.** Motion to enter nonpublic session pursuant to [RSA 91-A:3, II](#) for reasons of personnel, legal by Chairperson Knapp, seconded by Selectperson Ayer. Roll call vote: Ayer – Aye, Bailey – Aye, Mannschreck – Aye, Saccoccia – Aye. ***The motion passed.***

Present in Nonpublic session were Chairperson Knapp, Vice-Chair Saccoccia, Selectperson Bailey, Selectperson Ayer, Selectperson Mannschreck, TA MacIver, and MOA Caudle.

**10:33pm.** TA MacIver shared that the legal topic was 2A Tactical.

Selectperson Bailey and Selectperson Saccoccia recused themselves.

TA MacIver explained that the Town's attorney will need direction after the resolution of the 2A Tactical Zoning Board application. TA MacIver shared that the Town's attorney recommends proposing a settlement agreement if the Zoning Board denies their application. If the ZBA approves their application, she recommends staying the enforcement action until the decision is final and then dismissing it.

Motion, as recommended by legal counsel, to draft settlement proposal if 2A Tactical is denied a variance and stay/dismiss enforcement action if the Zoning Board approved the 2A Tactical application, by Chairperson Knapp, seconded by Selectperson Mannschreck. Roll call vote: Ayer – Aye, Mannschreck – Aye, Knapp – Aye ***The motion passed.***
