Article 23 Operating Budget

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$8,998,280? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$8,666,644, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Town or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. [Majority Vote Required]. This article is projected to add 13 cents/1,000 to the 2024 tax rate or \$56 to the tax bill on a \$425,000 property.


2023 Tax Rate



Barrington's Municipal Tax Rate Is Small


Barrington Compared to NH Municipalities Percentile (2023)




