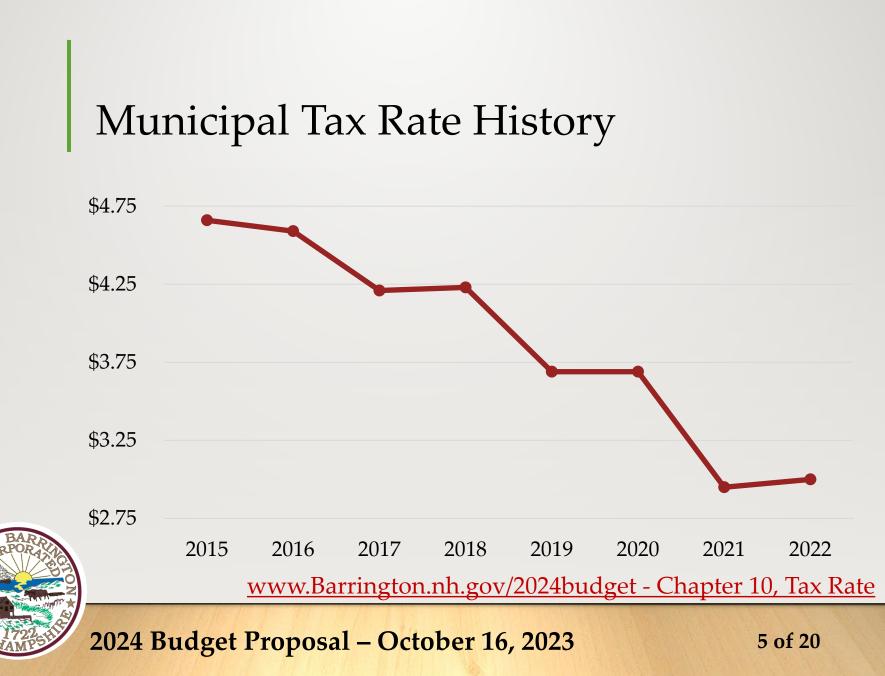

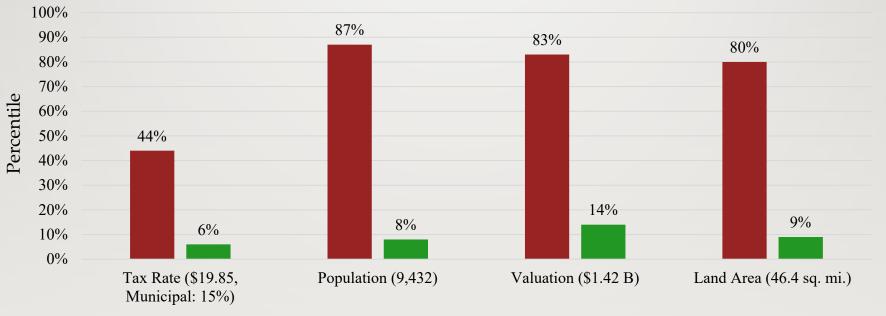

Measures of Financial Stability

- Stable Municipal Tax Rate
 - Limited Budgetary Tax Impact for ten years (budget increases covered by tax base and increased revenues)
- Unassigned Fund Balance of 8%-17% as Recommended by the NH Department of Revenue Administration
 - Barrington holds \$5,098,616 or 15.3%
 - *Note* This balance is higher than normal because all 2023 warrant articles were presented with a tax rate impact and the Select Board will use a proportional amount to reduce the tax rate at tax rate setting in 2023.

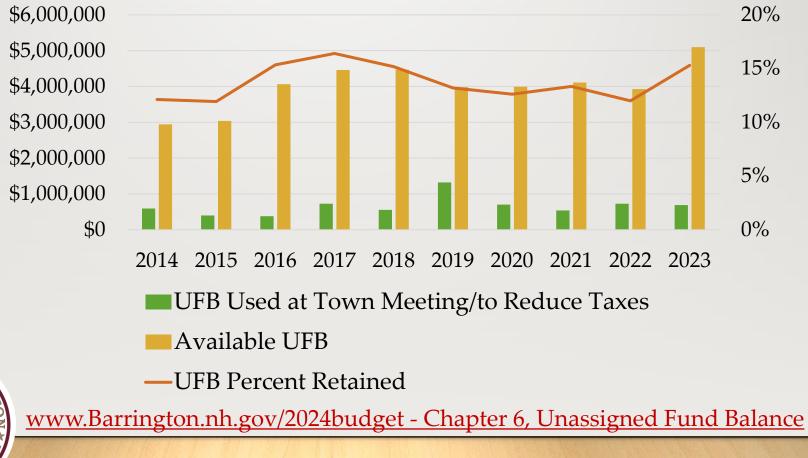

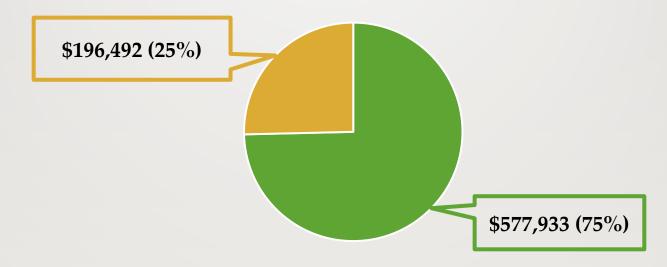

Wage and Benefit Budget Impact Factors

- Fire Department Staffing Changes: \$114,247
 - Wages for Full-Time Firefighter/EMTs Hired in 2022 (paid for from Ambulance Revolving in 2023
 - Increased Overtime for Shift Coverage
 - New Administrative Assistant (24 Hours Full-Year)
- Highway Seasonal Landscaping and PM Mechanic: \$32,122
- Recreation Administrative Assistant (+9 Hours to 34/week): \$24,337
- Building Department Add Part-Time Deputy (.5 FTE): \$23,138

Wage and Benefit Budget Impact Factors (cont.)

- Other Staffing Changes: \$384,089
 - Census Updates (primarily health elections): \$144,451
 - Pay Plan Step Increase Allowance (Merit): \$70,112
 - Cost of Living Adjustment (3%): \$80,142
 - Benefit Cost Increase (10% estimated): \$48,229
 - Election 4 Elections in 2024 v. 1 in 2023: \$12,000
 - Library Processor 27 to 40 hours Technology 40 to 24 Hours (approved in 2023): \$10,237
 - Transfer Station Thursday Hours All Year: \$8,652
 - Police Per-Diem Accreditation Specialist (240 Hours): \$8,572
 - Library Regrade Program and Social Media Specialist: \$1,694

Budget Decreases of (\$10,000)+

- Admin Contracts (\$37,200) to \$132,800
 - Reduced IT Services with New Provider, Moved 3CX Phone to Communications
- Gen. Govt. Bldgs. Equipment (\$27,854) to \$11,112
 - Reduced Equipment Needs

2024 Revenue Impacts

- State Approved Budget Increases Local Revenue
 - Meals and Rooms Distribution Increases
 - +\$160,000 (30%) in 2022
 - 2023 Will Have a Significant Increase (will know at tax rate setting)
 - 2024 Highway Block Grant: Expected to Remain Stable (\$227,179)
- Motor Vehicle Registration Revenue
 - Eight-Year Increase Trend Stabilized in 2022 and is Increasing Again
- Interest on Investments
 - Increases as Interest Rates Rise (\$30,000+ in August alone)

- \$150,000 Public Safety Building Design and Impact Fee Study
- \$150,000 Paving Non-Lapsing Warrant Article
- \$100,000 Fire Truck Capital Reserve

- \$3,000 Library Technology Capital Reserve
- \$1,673,000: Total Requested from Warrant Articles
