If any person shall die or remove from the town without having paid the tax aforesaid assessed against him and shall leave in said town no personal Estate on which distress can be made or in case any person or persons shall neglect to expose goods and chattels wheron distress may be made, you are directed to within one year from the first day of June next to sell so much of the real estate of such delinquent as will pay the taxes and incidental charges, and execute a conveyance of the same, in the manner prescribed by law.
