Sale of Nonresident Land in 1849

The following is a true account of the sales of the real estate of persons not resident in the town of Barrington for taxes assessed upon the same in said town for the year 1849, and which were sold pursuant to notice at public auction at the public house of Ephraim C. Tappin in said Barrington on the ninth day of February 1850.

Nine acres of Stephen Chesley land was sold to Samuel Hayes he being the highest bidder for \$2.90 to pay the taxes assessed on the same, Tax \$1.56 and incidental charges \$1.34 amounting to \$2.90.

Also twenty acres of Dexter Easton of the N. Caldwell land was sold to Samuel Hayes he being the highest bidder for \$4.34 to pay the taxes assessed in the same, Taxes \$3.00 incidental charges \$1.34 amounting to \$4.34.

Also six acres of Richard Pinkham land was sold to Samuel Hayes he being the highest bidder for \$1.64 to pay the taxes assessed on the same, Tax \$0.30 incidental charges \$1.34 amounting in the whole to \$1.64.

Also five acres of Richard Pinkham of the Steele land was sold to Samuel Hayes he being the highest bidder for \$1.94 to pay the taxes assessed on the same, Tax \$0.60 incidental charges \$1.34 amounting to \$1.94.

[L.S.] In the name of the State you are directed to levy and collect of the several persons named in the list herewith committed to you the taxes in said list set against their names, respectively the whole amounting to the sum of \$3987.42 cts

And we further order you to pay the same when collected as follows: To the treasurer of said state the sum of \$301.80 to be paid on or before the first day of December next; to the treasurer of the county of Shafford the sum of \$558.64 to be paid on or before the first day of December next, and to the treasurer of said town the remainder of said list as follows the sum of \$600.00 on or before the twentieth day of September next, and \$600.00 on or before the first day of January next; And the balance of said list on or before the tenth day of February next. The list aforesaid is a correct list of the assessment, of the State County town and school taxes for the year 1850 upon the rateable polls and estates of the inhabitants of said Barrington & of the school house tax assessed upon the rateable polls and estates in district No 8 in said town as made by us, the selectmen of said Barrington.

If any person named in in said list after having received from you a written notice of the tax for which he is liable given to him in person or left at his usual place of abode by you, shall neglect or refuse for the space of fourteen days to pay the same or if any corporation named in said list after a like notice, shall neglect or refuse to pay such tax or if you have reason to believe that any person named in said list is about to remove from town and such person shall on demand neglect or refuse to pay his tax you are directed to collect the same by distress and the sale of the goods of such person or corporation, in the mode prescribed by law.

But you are not to distress the tools or implements of any person necessary for his trade or occupation, nor his arms nor his utensils of household necessary for upholding life, nor bedding or apparel necessary for him or his family, nor the uniform, arms or equipments of any officer noncommissioned officer or private, and for want of goods and chattels whereupon to make distress, you are directed to take the body of any person refusing or neglecting to pay or aforesaid and to commit him to the common jail,

them to remain until discharged according to law,

If any person shall die or remove from the town without having paid the tax assessed against him and shall leave in said town no personal estate on which distress can be made or in case any person or persons shall neglect or refuse to expose goods and chattels whereupon distress may be made, you are directed within one year from the first day of June next to sell so much of the real estate of such delinquent as will pay the taxes and incidental charges and execute a conveyance of the same in the manner prescribed by law,
