each delinquent estate as will be sufficient to pay said
Taxes and incidental charges.

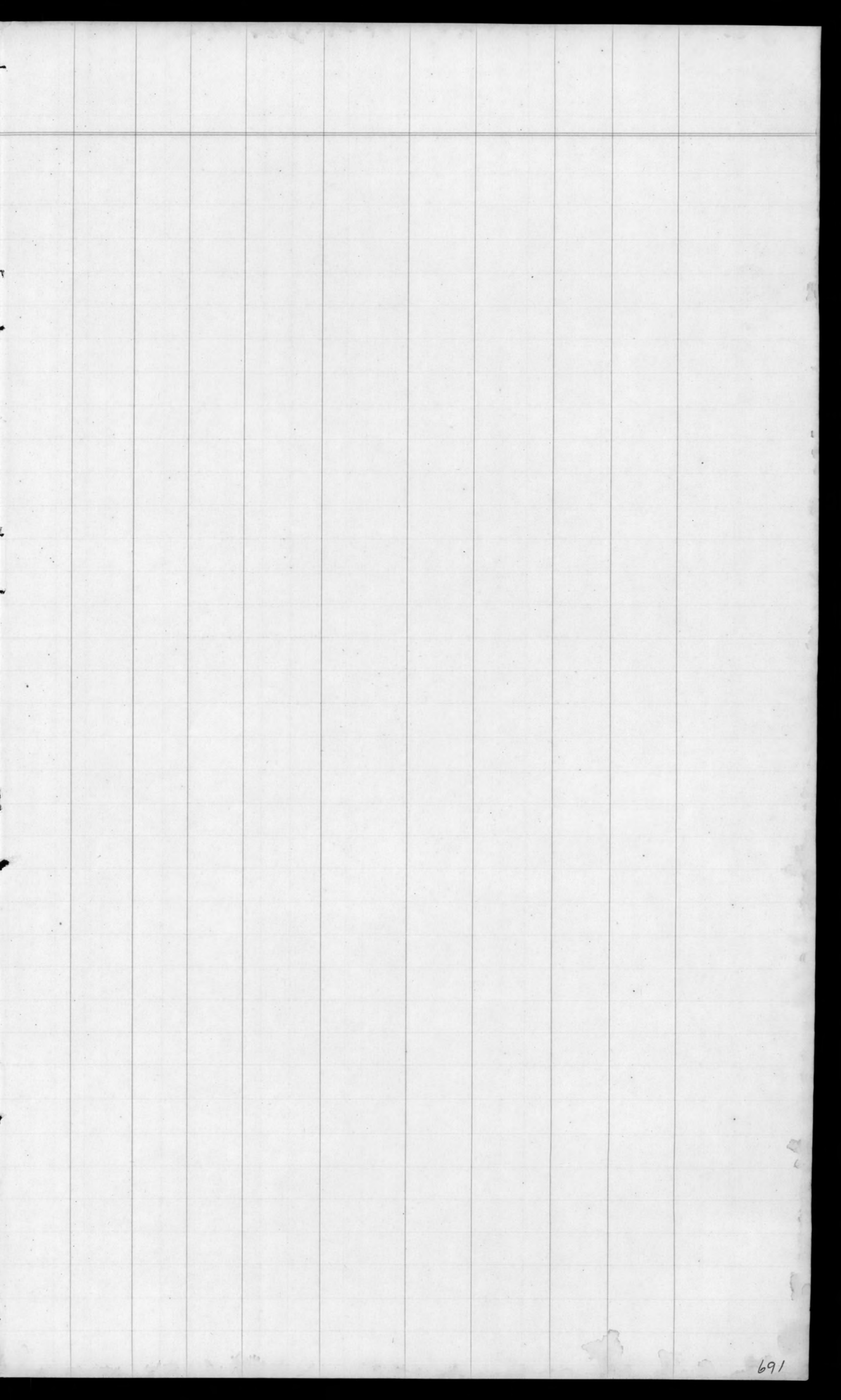

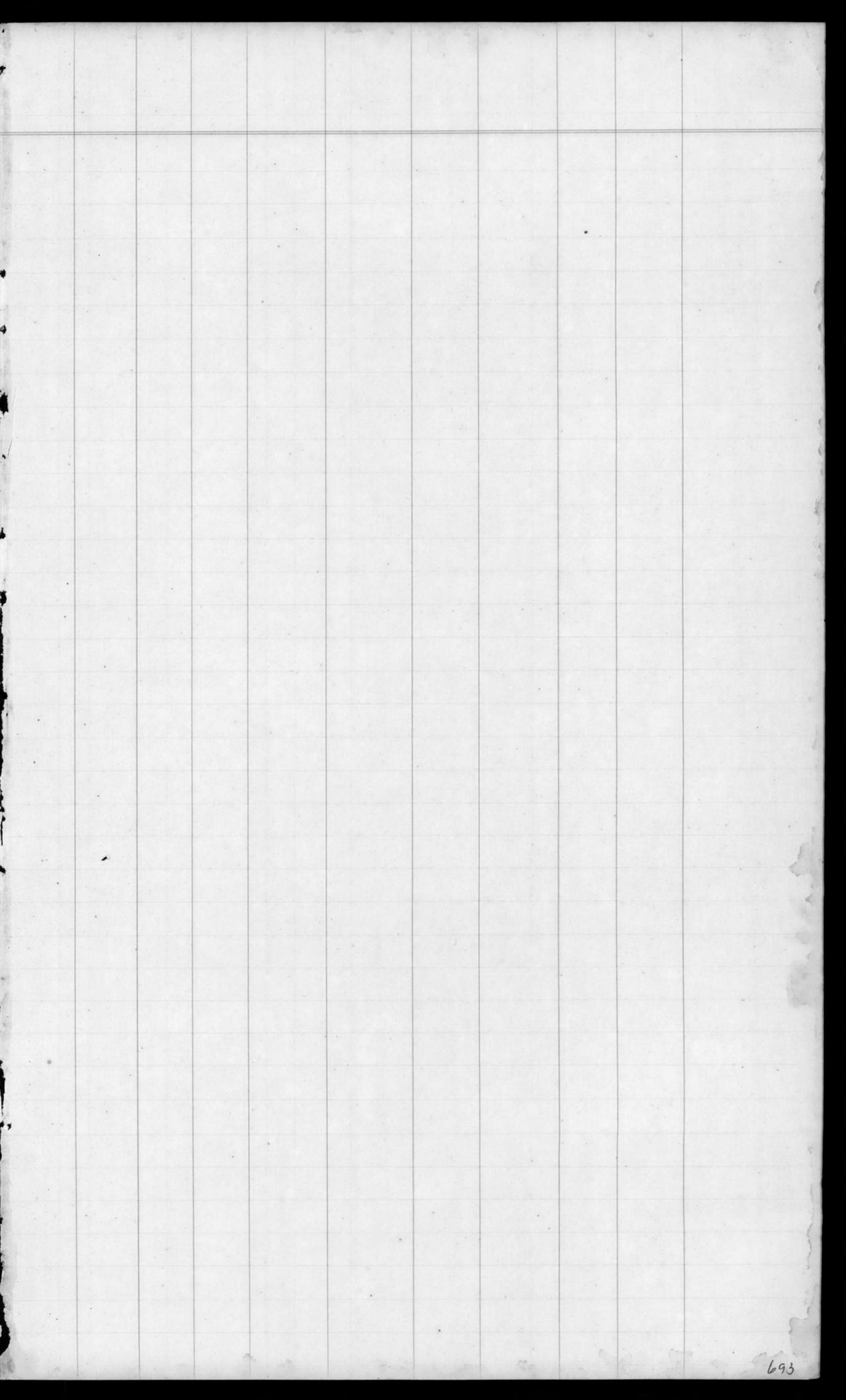
