 To William C. Boddy, collector of Taxes for the town of Barrington,  
 in the County of Strafford:

In the name of said state you are required to collect of the persons and corporations named in the following annexed list of taxes the sums set against their respective names amounting in all to the sum of \$6925.65. Six thousand nine hundred & twenty five <sup>65</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars, with ten per cent. interest from the first day of December next on all sums not paid before that day, and to pay to the treasurer of said town \$4000. Four thousand Dollars on or before the first Saturday of December next, and the residue of said taxes and interest on or before the first Saturday of February 1887.

You are also required on the first Saturday of every month to pay to said treasurer all money then collected and not before paid to him, and at the same time submit to him your tax-book and tax-list for his inspection and computation. Upon neglect after due notice of any persons or corporations named in said list to pay the tax assessed against them respectively, you are directed to distrain their goods and chattels and for want of goods and chattels wherupon to make distress of any such person neglecting or refusing to pay the tax assessed against him, to take his body and commit him to the common jail in said county and the jailor shall receive and detain him in his custody until he pays such tax, cost of commitment and charges of imprisonment or is otherwise discharged by due course of law.
