On the name of said State you are required to collect of the several persons and corporations named in the following annexed list herewith committed to you. The taxes set against their respective names amounting in all to the sum of \$7417.69 including Poor Taxes with ten per cent interest from the first day of December next on all sums not paid on or before that day and to pay the same to the Treasurer of said Barrington on demand. You are further required to pay to said Treasurer on the first Saturday of every month, all money collected by you up to that time and not before paid to him and at the same time to submit your tax book and list to him for his inspection and computation. The list on the following pages which is hereby made a part of the Warrant is a correct list of all the taxes assessed for the year 1890 upon the ratable polls and estates of said town of Barrington as made by us the Select men of said Barrington. If any person named in said list after having received from you a notice of the Tax of which he is liable given to him in person or left at his usual place of abode by you shall neglect or refuse for the space of fourteen days to pay the same or if any Corporation named in said list after a notice shall neglect or refuse to pay such tax, or if you have any reason to believe that any person named in such list is about to remove from town and such person shall on demand refuse or neglect to pay his tax or if the tax is against a person who is not an inhabitant of this State or if the person against whom the tax is, has removed from town you are directed to collect the same

by distress and sale of the goods of such person or corporation in the mode prescribed by law. But you are not to distrain the tools or implements of any person necessary for his trade or occupation nor his arms nor his utensils of household necessary for upholding life, nor bedding nor apparel necessary for him or his family. And for want of goods and chattels whereon to make distress you are directed to take the body of any person refusing or neglecting to pay as aforesaid and to commit him to the common jail there to remain till he pays such tax costs of commitment and charges of imprisonment, or is otherwise discharged by due course of law. If any person shall die or remove from town without paying the tax aforesaid assessed against him and shall leave any personal estate in said town upon which distress can be made, Or in case any person or corporation shall neglect or refuse to expose any goods and chattels when on distress can be made you are directed within one year from the first day of June following to sell so much of the real estate of such delinquent as will pay the taxes and incidental expenses and charges and to execute a conveyance of the same in the manner prescribed by law.
