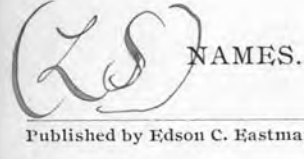

The list on the following pages which is hereby made a part of this warrant, is a correct list of all taxes assessed for the year 1901 upon the ratable polls and estates of said Barrington as made by us the Selectmen of said Barrington. If any person in said list after having received from you a notice of the tax for which he is liable given to him in person or left at his usual place of abode by you, shall neglect or refuse for the space of fourteen days to pay the same, or if any corporation named in said list after a like notice shall neglect or refuse to pay its tax or if the tax is against a person who is not an inhabitant of this state, or if the person against whom the tax is, has remained from town you are hereby directed to collect the same by distress and sale of the goods of such persons, or corporations, in the way prescribed by Law. But you are not to distress the tools or ~~implements~~

of and person necessary for his trade or occupation nor his arms, nor his utensils or household necessaries for upholding life nor bedding necessary for him or his family. For want of goods and chattels whereon to make distress you are directed to take the body of any person neglecting or refusing as aforesaid and to commit him to the jail there to remain until he pays such tax, cost of commitment and charges of imprisonment or is otherwise discharged by due course of law, if any person shall die or remove from the town without paying the tax aforesaid assessed against him, and shall leave in said town no personal estate upon which distress can be made or in case any person or corporation shall neglect or refuse to expose goods, and chattels whereon distress can be made, you are directed the first day of June following to sell so much of the real estate of such delinquent as will pay the taxes and incidental charges, and to execute a conveyance of the same in the manner prescribed by law.

In the name of said state you are required to collect the taxes in the following list amounting in all to the sum of two thousand nine hundred and sixty three Dollars and sixty three cents (\$2963.⁶³/₁₀₀) with interest at ten per cent from the first day of December next on all sums not paid on or before that day and pay to the treasurer of said town on or before the last Saturday of February next.

You are also required on the first Saturday of every month to pay to said Treasurer, all money then collected and not before paid to him, and at the same time to submit your tax book and list to him for his inspection and computation.

In the name of said State you are directed to levy and collect of the several persons named in the list herewith committed to you the taxes in said list set against their names respectively, with interest at ten per cent from the first day of December next on all sums not paid on or before that day, the whole amounting to the sum of \$10176.01 ten thousand one hundred seventy six and ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars.

And we further order you to pay the same when collected to the Treasurer of said town on demand.

The list on the following pages is a correct list of the assessment of the State County Town and School taxes for the year 1902 upon the ratable polls and inhabitants of said Barrington as made by us the Selectmen of said Barrington

If any person named in said list, after having received from you a written notice of the tax for which he is liable, given to him in person, or left at his usual place of abode by you, shall neglect or refuse for the space of fourteen days to pay the same, or if any corporation named in said list after a like notice, shall neglect or refuse to pay such tax, or if you have any reason to believe that any person named in said list is about to remove from town, and such person shall on demand neglect or refuse to pay his tax, you are directed to collect the same by distress and sale of the goods of such person or corporation in the mode prescribed by law but you are not to distress the tools or implements of any

person necessary for his trade or occupation nor his utensils of household necessary for upholding life: nor bedding or apparel necessary for him or his family: nor the uniform, arms or equipment of any officer, non commissioned officer or private And for want of good and chattels whereon to make distress you are directed to take the body of any person refusing or neglecting to pay as aforesaid and to commit him to the common jail there to remain until discharged according to law.

If any person shall die or remove from the town without having paid the tax aforesaid, ~~estate upon which distress can be made or im-~~ assessed against him and shall leave in said town no personal estate upon which distress can be made ~~in~~ in case any person or persons shall neglect or refuse to expose good and chattels whereon distress may be made you are directed within one year from the first day of June next, to sell so much of the real estate of such delinquent as will pay the taxes and incidental charges and to execute a conveyance of the same in the manner prescribed by law.

On the first Saturday of every month you will pay over to the town Treasurer all moneys by you collected and not previously paid to him and will also submit your tax book and list to him for inspection and computation.
