

The 2024 Proposed budget shows an increase of \$23,700.

A 6.3% increase from 2023. This increase is from the PT hourly wage line, the benefit line for employees, Recycling, Dues/Fees, and Operating Supplies. Please note that some of these lines are offset by the revenue generated at the Transfer Station which is estimated to be at \$213,000 at years end.
