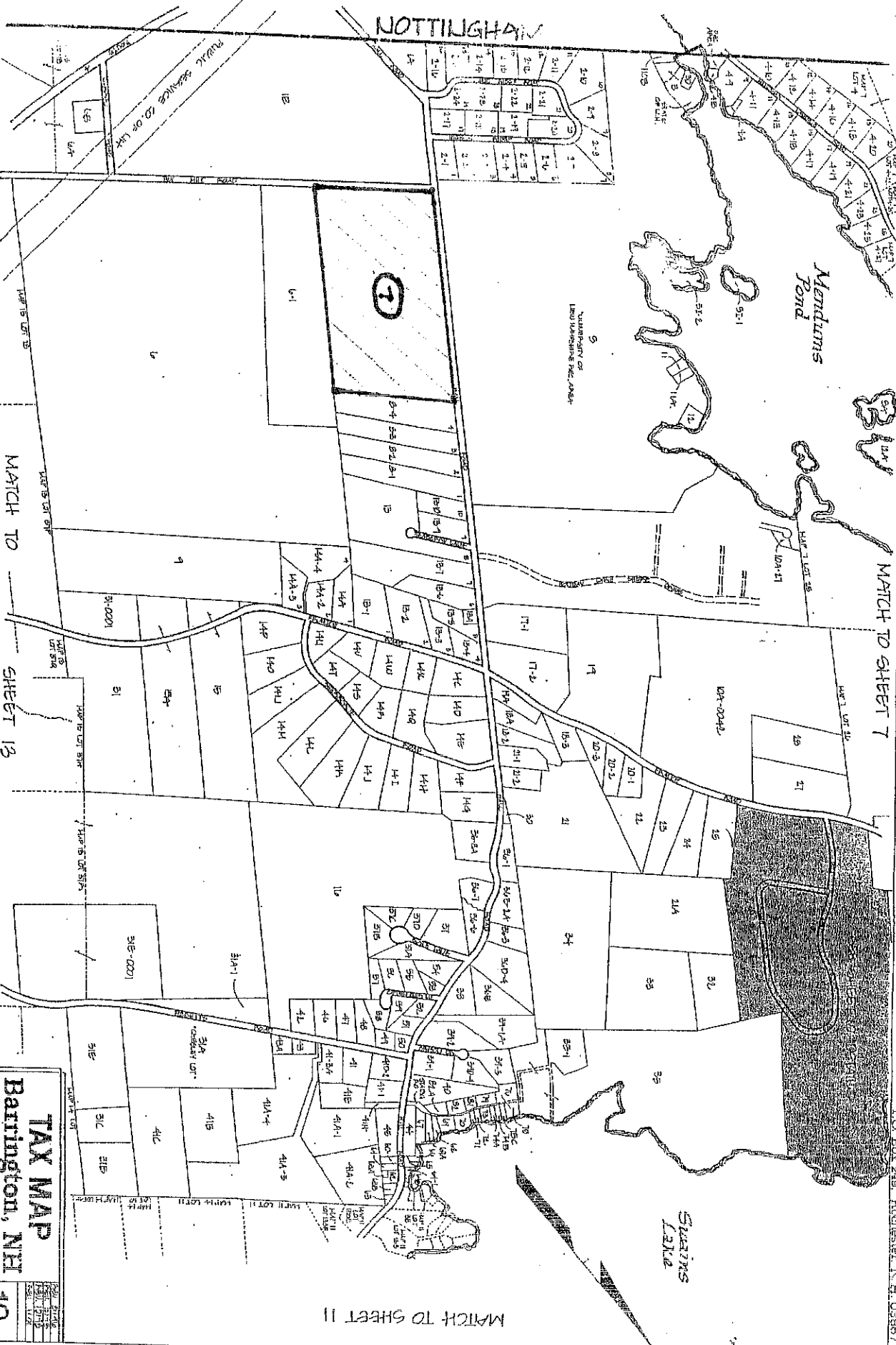

Under RSA 482-A, our client is required to notify you that they are applying for a permit from the NH Department of Environmental Services (DES) Wetlands Bureau. This letter is to inform you, as an abutter (Barrington Tax Map 10, Lots 6-1 and 8-4) to the above-referenced property, that an application for a permit has been filed with the NH DES Wetlands Bureau. 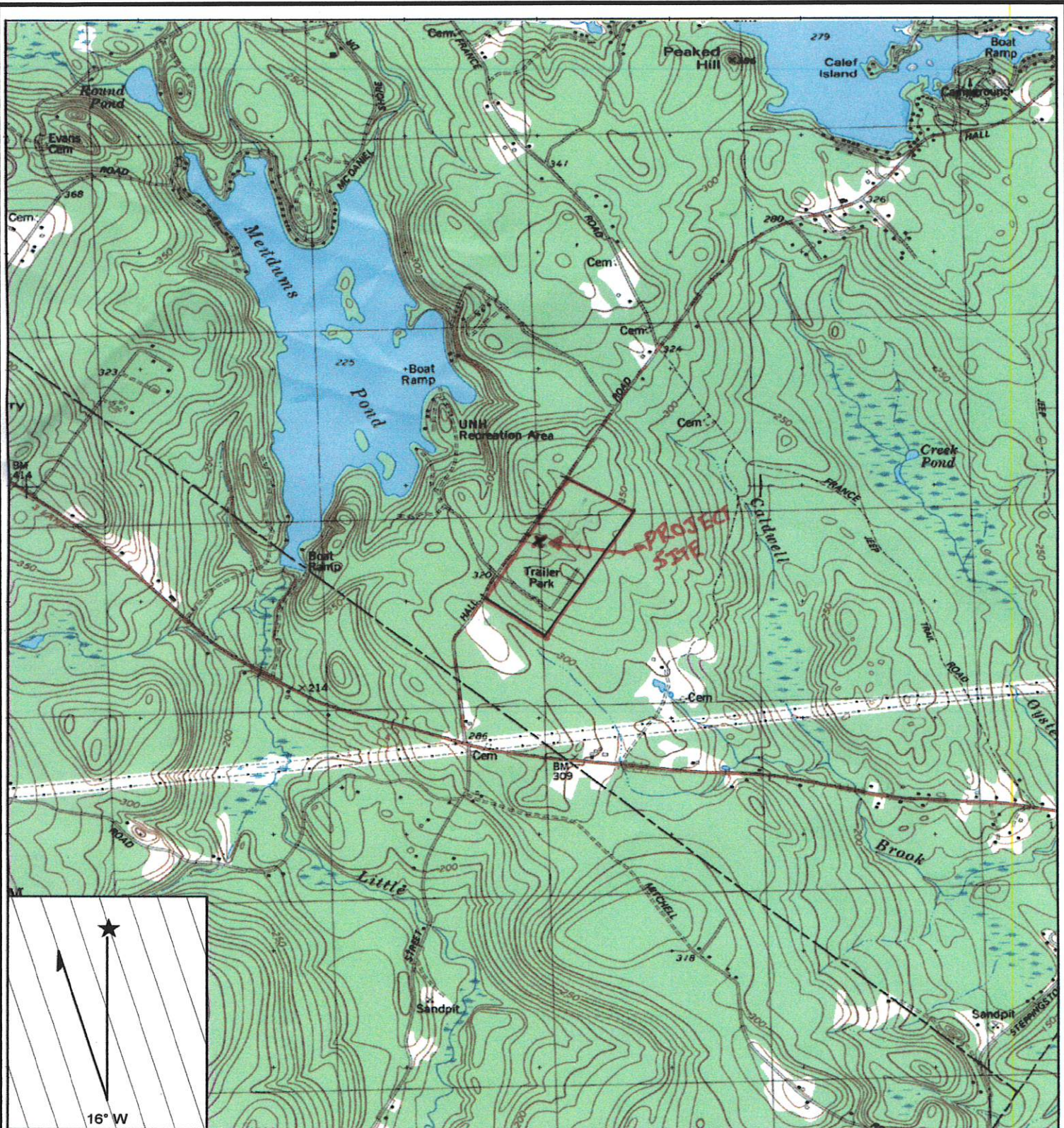
