From the Desk of the Chief:

First, let me preface this message by assuring the citizens of the Town of Barrington that their Police Department will still be responding to all calls for service. You will experience no change in the service regarding emergency and other priority calls. You might notice some minor changes in how we handle personal interaction during those calls, but at no time will emergency services suffer.

The Barrington Police Department will be making a strong effort to protect the public amid the current pandemic. We share the responsibility of promoting social distancing and limiting interaction at this time. Thus, we ask that, whenever possible, the public refrain from coming to the police station to report non-emergency calls. We are asking that you report calls for service to our Dispatch line, 603-664-7679. In addition, please utilize our online presence to request reports, etc. at [kperry@barrington.nh.gov](mailto:kperry@barrington.nh.gov). Pistol Permit applications can be accessed online at the Department of Safety and can be emailed, faxed or mailed to the police department. We will accept them in hand if necessary.

We are taking these actions, along with others, in consideration for the safety of the public and our staff. As a result, you may see changes in the way we conduct ourselves daily in order to protect the health of those in need of assistance. This may include, but is not limited to, being contacted by phone or being asked to step outside to speak to an officer. You may also notice the use of masks or gloves during what would be considered a "normal" encounter. We will not be suspending applicant fingerprints, but we will be limiting that service to those required to fulfill necessary, pandemic related roles. Please call and we will do our best to accommodate you.

The Barrington Police Department will remain open during normal business hours and we will continue to respond to calls for service 24/7. We simply ask the public to limit personal contact as much as possible.

I appreciate the anticipated understanding of the Barrington community. We remain committed to serving the community as best we can while taking precautions to best protect the public and our staff.
