You are hereby notified that the request of <u>ZB12/122/26 – Paul Silver Rev. Trust, by: Jones &</u> <u>Beach Engineers, Inc.</u>, for a Variance from the terms of the Barrington Zoning Ordinance has been <u>GRANTED</u> for the following reasons:

After a consideration of the petitioners application, and after consideration of all evidence presented to the Board at the public hearing, held on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 17, 2012</u>, it is the decision of the Board that the unique facts in the specific case # <u>ZB12/122-26</u> authorize a Variance from the terms of the Ordinance. It is the decision of the Board that owing to the special conditions of the <u>Silver's</u> case, that a literal enforcement of the Ordinance will result in unnecessary hardship and so by <u>GRANTING</u> a Variance in this specific case, the spirit of the ordinance is observed and substantial justice is done.
